#### 1. ORGANISATION OF THE EVENT

The Asian Games comes under the direct authority of the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA). The 19<sup>th</sup> Asian Games Hangzhou 2022 (HAG2022) was organised by the local organising committee (LOC) of the Hangzhou Asian Games Organising Committee (HAGOC) in collaboration with the OCA, and the respective Asian Continental Sport governing body.

Being a multi-sports event, the registration of teams, athletes and team officials in an Asian Games come under the authority of the respective National Olympic Committee (NOC) which are members of the OCA.

The HAG2022 were to have been held from 10-25 September 2022 but due to the global Covid-19 pandemic, was postponed to 23 September -08 October 2023. Despite it being held in the year 2023, the name of the event with the year was retained as "19<sup>th</sup> Asian Games Hangzhou 2022", hence HAG2022.

Women Softball competition as well as Men Baseball were included in the HAG2022 sports programme. The postponed dates for the Women Softball competition were fixed from 26 September to 02 October 2023. The technical and competition management of the Women Softball competition in the HAG2022 was organised by Softball Asia (SA), as the recognised governing body for Softball in Asia.

# 2. THE $19^{\mathrm{TH}}$ ASIAN GAMES HANGZHOU 2022 (HAG2022) – WOMEN SOFTBALL COMPETITION

#### 2.1 REGISTRATION AND ACCREDITATION

2.1.1 All registration and applications for accreditation of athletes and team officials were made through the respective NOC of the participating teams in accordance with the following deadlines:

Entry by Sport deadline: 20 February 2021
Entry by Number deadline: 15 March 2023
Entry by Name deadline: 15 July 2023
Close of Accreditation: 20 May 2023

2.1.2 The number of ITOs was agreed upon between OCA, HAGOC and SA. SA was responsible for the registration and applications for accreditation of the ITOs appointed. The number of NTOs was agreed upon between OCA, HAGOC, SA and Chinese Softball Association (CSA). CSA was responsible for the registration and applications for accreditation for the NTOs appointed.



#### 2.2 AIR TRAVEL AND LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

- 2.2.1 HAGOC provided and paid for the air travel (on economy class fare with one (1) extra check-in bag for each official) for the appointed ITOs. NTOs were provided the appropriate transport within China.
- 2.2.2 All accreditated athletes, team officials and ITOs were provided airport pick-up and send-off upon his/her respective arrival and departure to/from Hangzhou.
- 2.2.3 Local scheduled transportation was also provided for the ITOs and NTOs in Shaoxing, where the Women Softball competition was held to/from the official hotels competition-training venues. Services were available from 26 September to 03 October 2023 for the Softball competition.
- 2.2.4 A specific number of dedicated vehicles (with drivers) were also given to each NOC delegation for its exclusive use. Participating teams were provided dedicated bus transport to/from the Athletes Sub-Village competition / training venue. Please refer to the Detailed Transport Services Plan for the HAG2022 for more details.

#### 2.3 ACCOMMODATION AND MEALS

- 2.3.1 During the 19th Asian Games, since the Softball competition venue was in Shaoxing:
  - The athletes and team officials of the 8 participating teams stayed in the HAG Athletes Sub-Village at the Hangzhou Bay Accounting Academy, 28, Xingyue East Road, Dongpu Street, Yuecheng District, Shaoxing city.
  - The Technical Officials stayed at the Jianhu (Mirror Lake) Hotel, 518, Keyan Avenue, Keyan Street, Keqiao District, Shaoxing.
- 2.3.2 For security, access to the different zones in the Athletes Sub-Village required the appropriate accreditation card.
- 2.3.3 For the technical officials, HAGOC provided 3 meals per day (breakfast at the hotel and lunch plus dinner vide packed box meals at the competition venue).

#### 2.4 MEDICAL SERVICES

- 2.4.1 Medical rooms (medical stations) were set up and ambulances available at competition and training venues. During the opening periods of venues, professional medical staff were on-site to provide Games participants with basic medical services, first aid and patient referrals, where needed. A Polyclinic was set up in the Athletes Sub-Village.
- 2.4.2. Professional medical staff provide basic medical services, first aid and patient referral services to Games participants where needed, 24 hours a day. Basic medical, on-site emergency and patient referral services will be provided free of charge. Other medical services were to be paid for in accordance with the provisions stated in the relevant insurance cover policy or by the individual receiving treatment.
- 2.4.3 There was one (1) injury (sprained ankle) suffered by one of the athletes from the Philippines team and she was taken for an X-ray at the attending hospital in

Shaoxing. As no major injury which required hospitalisation was indicated, she was discharged on the same day.

# 2.5 PRE-COMPETITION TEAM LEADERS-MANAGERS MEETING

2.5.1 A Pre-competition Team Leaders - Managers Meeting was held as follows for the Team Leaders/Team Managers/Head Coaches of the teams' briefing:

Date: 25 September 2023

Time: 03:00pm

Venue: Press Conference Room, Shaoxing Softball Stadium.

2.5.2 All the participating teams were represented by their respective Team Leaders-Team Managers-Head Coaches-Coaches. They took the opportunity to clarify matters regarding the Softball competition.



2.5.3 It was an honour when WBSC President Mr. Riccardo Fraccari attended the Meeting to give his welcome remarks and offered words of encouragement to all the participating teams and the organizing team.

### 2.6 COMPETITION FORMAT

The Softball competition format had 3 stages as follows:

- (i) First Stage: A Preliminary Round Robin Group Round.
- (ii) Second Stage: A Super Round and a Placement Round.
- (iii) Third Stage: The Play-off Finals medals Round.
- 2.6.1 The 8 participating teams were placed into 2 groups, namely, Group A and Group B, for a Preliminary Single Round Robin stage within each Group.

Group B
B1 – China (CHN)
B2 – Philippines (PHI)
B3 – South Korea (KOR)
B4 – Thailand (THA)

- 2.6.2 The top 2 teams from each group advanced to the next Super Round competition, while the remaining 2 teams in each Group competed in the Placement Round.
- 2.6.3 In the Play-off Finals Medals Round, the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> placed teams after the completion of the Super Round played for the bronze medal; whilst the 1st and 2nd placed teams played for the gold medal.



#### 2.7 TRAINING AND COMPETITION VENUES

- 2.7.1 The competition venue, namely, the Shaoxing Softball Stadium within the Shaoxing Baseball-Softball Sports Centre, had 2 Field-of-Play areas: Softball Field A and Softball Field B.
- 2.7.2 It was mutually agreed between SA and HAGOC that Field A would be used for the competition, whereas Field B would be used for warm-up purposes.
- 2.7.3 Each participating team had 2 training sessions, one on Field A and one on Field B, each session for 60 minutes per field on 24 September 2023 and 25 September 2023 respectively. These sessions took place on both fields.






