1. ORGANISATION OF THE EVENTS

The 2nd U15 Women Softball Asia Cup 2025 tournament (**the Tournament**), which was also a **World Cup Qualifier**, was held in the township of **Puli, in Nantou County**, TPE. Puli is located in the mountainous centre of the Taiwan island, in the Puli Basin. It is the geographic centre of the island, with many tourist destinations, such as the Sun Moon Lake nearby.

The Tournament was organised by Softball Asia (SA), in collaboration with the Chinese Taipei Softball Association (CTSA). The dates and venue for the Tournament were as follows:

 Practical – Tournament: 26 – 30 March 2025

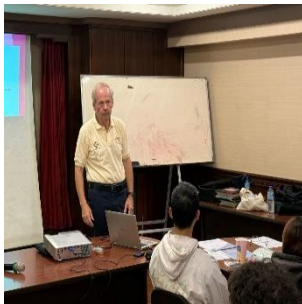
The Technical Commissioners Seminar was conducted by the Chairman of the WBSC Technical Commission, Mr. Chester (Chet) Gray from Australia.

2.3 OUTCOME OF THE TCs SEMINAR

All participants attended two (2) days of theory – classroom sessions on 24 & 25 March 2025, and the Seminar topics included the following, followed by a written test taken on 25 March 2025.

- The Role of TCs during a tournament
- The TCs documents for a tournament
- The WBSC TC Manual
- The WBSC TC Academy
- Case history and case studies
- The WBSC

The participants did a Tournament Venue inspection and assessment on 25 March 2025, and continued with practical field-tournament practical sessions during the Tournament period from 26 – 30 March 2025, under the supervision of the TCs Seminar instructor and the Technical Delegates.

All of them completed the TCs Seminar and were given Certificates of Participation. They would next be required to take the online course on the WBSC TCs Academy for Technical Commissioners, available on the WBSC website.

3. THE TOURNAMENT: 2nd U15 WOMEN SOFTBALL ASIA CUP 2025 – WORLD CUP QUALIFIER

3.1 PARTICIPATING TEAMS, AGE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA AND SPECIFIC REGULATIONS FOR THE TOURNAMENT

3.1.1 Participating teams

There were six (6) participating teams, namely,

- Hong Kong China HKG 
- India IND 
- Japan JPN 
- Korea (South) KOR 
- Singapore SGP 
- Chinese Taipei TPE 

3.1.2 Age Eligibility Criteria

For this U15 Tournament, **13 – 15 years old** athletes-players were eligible. Accordingly, those born in the years **2012, 2011 and 2010** were eligible.

The age eligibility of this 2025 Asia Cup aligned with that set by the WBSC Tournament Regulations for the WBSC U15 Women Softball World Cup 2025, where 13 – 15 years old athletes-players were eligible to participate.

3.1.3 Specific Regulations for the Tournament

Amongst the **Specific Tournament Regulations**, which were aligned with those set by the WBSC Tournament Regulations for the WBSC World Cup U15 Women Softball, were the following:

- (i) There were NO restrictions on the bat length and weight.
- (ii) The official competition ball used was the Mizuno Yellow optic 12-inch ball (M170).
- (iii) All games were seven-7-innings’ games EXCEPT where the Tie-break Rule or the Run-Difference Rule applied. Extra-innings were to start in the 8th inning.
- (iv) The following Run-Difference Rules were applied:
 - By fifteen (15) runs or more after the completion of three (3) innings.
 - By ten (10) runs or more after the completion of four (4) innings.
 - By seven (7) runs or more after the completion of five (5) innings.
- (v) No metal cleats were allowed.
- (vi) Helmets must include a guard/mask to protect the face for batters.
- (vii) Whilst it was NOT mandatory for pitchers nor the defense team members to wear face masks, it was encouraged.

3.2 ACCOMMODATION, MEALS & LOCAL TRANSPORT

3.2.1 Accommodation & Meals

- (i) The six (6) participating teams were accommodated at the following hotel in Puli:

Cheng Pao Hotel
No. 299, Zhongxiao Road, Puli Township, Nantou County

- (ii) All SA and tournament officials also stayed at the Cheng Pao Hotel and were placed on separate floors/separate wing from the athletes and team officials of the participating teams.
- (iii) The LOC also provided three-(3)-meals per day, with breakfast and dinner at the hotel, whilst lunch was by way of lunch-boxes served at the Tournament Venue. The LOC allocated separate spaces for the participating teams to take their lunch at the Tournament Venue.

3.2.2 Local Transport

The LOC provided buses/vans for airport pick-up and send-off from/to:

- The Taoyuan International Airport Taipei (TPE), which is about 210 km from the official hotel, Cheng Pao Hotel Puli, and about 2.5 – 3.0 hours by road from TPE; and
- The Songshan International Airport Taipei (TSA), which is about 230 km from the official hotel, Cheng Pao Hotel Puli, and about 3.0 – 3.5 hours by road from TSA;

as well as local transport by dedicated vans/bus from/to the official hotel to/from the Tournament-training Venues for the participating teams, and the SA and Tournament officials.

3.3 MEDICAL SERVICES

3.3.1 During the Tournament period, doctors and professional medical staff were on-site to provide athletes with basic medical services, first aid and patient referrals, where needed.

3.3.2 Basic medical, on-site emergency and patient referral services were to be provided free of charge. Other medical services were to be paid for in accordance with the provisions stated in the relevant insurance cover policy or by the individual or participating team receiving treatment.

3.4 PRESS CONFERENCE AND PRE-TOURNAMENT MEETING

3.4.1 A **Press Conference** was held by the CTSA and LOC as follows for a media briefing, with a good turnout from the local press and media representatives:

3.4.2 A **Pre-Tournament Organizational and Technical Meeting** was held as follows for the Team Leaders/Team Managers/Head Coaches of the teams for a briefing:

Date: 25 March 2025

Time: 17:00 (05.00 pm)

Venue: Cheng Pao Hotel Puli

All the participating teams were present through its/their respective Team Leaders/ Team Managers/Head coaches/Coaches. They were also able to clarify matters raised about the Tournament.



3.5 TOURNAMENT FORMAT

The Tournament Format consisted of the following 2 stages:

Stage 1: Preliminary Single Round Robin.

Stage 2: Placement Game and Finals – Medals Games.

- 3.5.1 The six (6) participating teams played a Preliminary Single Round Robin competition
- 3.5.2 The 5th and 6th placed teams after the completion of the Preliminary Round completion played a Placement Game to determine the 5th and 6th placings in the Tournament.
- 3.5.3 The 3rd and 4th placed teams after the completion of the Preliminary Round completion played in the Bronze medal game, with the winner being awarded the Bronze medal.
- 3.5.4 The 1st and 2nd placed teams after the completion of the Preliminary Round competition played in the Gold medal game, with the winner being awarded the Gold medal and title of “**Asia Champion of U15 Women Softball**”

3.6 TRAINING, WARM-UP AND TOURNAMENT VENUES

- 3.6.1 There was **one (1) field-of-play (Field A) at the Tournament Venue**, namely, the Fu-Hsing Softball Stadium. The **warm-up field** was located in a different venue, located near the official hotel and about twenty (20) minutes from the Tournament Venue; participating teams were transported from there to the Tournament Venue by bus.
- 3.6.2 The six (6) participating teams each had **one (1) training session** of sixty (60) minutes on the Tournament Venue at the Fu-Hsing Softball Stadium Softball Stadium, on 25 March 2025 (the day before the start of the Tournament).
