The 2nd U23 Men Softball Asia Cup 2025 (the Tournament), which also served as the WBSC U23 Men Softball World Cup 2026 Qualifier, was held in the Baseball – Softball Stadium, Queen Sirikit Sports Center, Pathum Thani, (Bangkok), Thailand.

2.1 ACCOMMODATION, MEALS, LOCAL TRANSPORT & LIAISON

2.1.1 Accommodations & Meals

The six (6) participating teams, SA and Tournament officials, as well as the LOC officials, stayed at the official hotel, namely, Novotel Bangkok Future Park Rangsit Hotel, Pathum Thani, Thailand.

The LOC also provided three-(3) meals per day (breakfast and dinner at the official hotel, whilst lunch was by way of "buffet" catered and served at the Tournament venue).

2.1.2 Local Transport

The LOC provided dedicated buses for all teams and officials, including for:

- Airport pick-up and drop-off between the official hotel and Suvarnabhumi International Airport / Don Mueang International Airport.
- Transfers between the official hotel and Tournament-training venue.
- Standby vehicles for transfers between the official hotel and Tournament-training venue.

The LOC provided one (1) liaison personnel per participating team.



2.2 PRE-TOURNAMENT TEAM LEADERS MEETING

2.2.1 A Pre-Tournament Team Leaders Meeting was held as follows for the Team Leaders/Team Manager/Head Coaches of the teams:

- 2.2.2 The six (6) participating teams were represented through their respective Team Leaders/ Team Manager/ Head Coaches/Coaches. They were also able to clarify matters raised in relation to the Tournament.
- 2.2.3 At the conclusion of the Meeting, a Coin Toss was held to determine the respective "Home" and "Visiting" Teams for the games in the Preliminary Round. In the Placement Round, and the Finals Medal Games, the higher ranked team upon the completion of the Preliminary round, was designated the "Home" team, and the opposing team, the "Visting" team.







2.3 TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- 2.3.1 The Tournament format was a single round robin Preliminary Round amongst the six (6) participating teams, where the teams played one (1) game against each other, over four (4) days of competition.
- 2.3.2 Upon the completion of the Preliminary Round competition:
 - The 5th and 6th placed teams played in the Placement Game, to determine the 5th and 6th placings in the Tournament.
 - The 3rd and 4th placed teams played for the Bronze medal, with the winner being awarded the Bronze medal.
 - The 1st and 2nd placed teams played for the Gold medal, with the winner being awarded the Gold medal and title of "Asia Champion of U23 Men Softball Asia Cup 2025".



3. THE TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATION

PARTICIPATING TEAMS, ELIGIBILITY AND SPECIFIC REGULATIONS FOR THE TOURNAMENT

3.1 There were six (6) participating teams, namely,

- 3.2 The eligibility for the Tournament was restricted by age, based on the following Rule A1.12 of the WBSC Tournament Regulations for the U-23 Men Softball World Cup:
 - Rule A1.12 of the WBSC Tournament Regulations: "For the U-23 Men Softball World Cup, 14–23-year-old athletes-players are eligible. Exceptionally, those athletes-players born in 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011 and 2012 are eligible for the U-23 Men Softball World Cup 2026".
- 3.3 The other **Specific Tournament Regulations**, aligned also with those set by the WBSC Official Rules of Softball 2022 2025, WBSC Safeguarding from Harassment and Abuse Rules, WBSC Safeguarding Guidelines, and WBSC Softball Uniform Guidelines.
 - 3.3.1 There were bat checks to ensure that bats used for the Tournament were in accordance with the WBSC Softball Approval Bats List.
 - 3.3.2 The official Tournament ball used was the Mizuno M170 (Yellow).
 - 3.3.3 The Team Quality Balance (TQB) Rule was applicable in the event of a tie-break involving three (3) or more teams that head-to-head could not break. If there were a tie in the TQB, the team that with the best Earned Runs TQB (ER-TQB) would be placed higher.
 - 3.3.4 All games were seven-(7)-innings games EXCEPT where the Tie-break Rule, or the following Run-Difference Rule applied.
 - By fifteen (15) runs or more, after the completion of three (3) innings.
 - By ten (10) runs or more, after the completion of four (4) innings.
 - By seven (7) runs or more, after the completion of five (5) innings.
